POL-3280	5.5	Acquisitions/Enriched EDI: When a partial shipment was received and the PO line item (POLI) was split (qty shipped less than qty ordered), the linked shelf-ready items that were updated were not necessarily the same items that were being received on the POLI. This was because the MARC import file always referenced the original POLI segment prior to the split. Internal information has been added to the POLI to retain a link back to the original POLI segment when split in order to receive the same items that are being	292112	
POL-1446	5.5	Circ: Holds were not being reactivated correctly when the item status was modified via Manage Item Record or Special Item Check in. This caused some items to appear on the Picklist when they shouldn't. This has been	270310	
POL-3849	5.5	Circulation/Floating: Floating parameters were set to float by collection (no load balancing). An item was checked in at a branch over the collection limit and the staff member clicked 'No' to _not_ check in the item at the check-in branch. POL-3592	5.5	Circulation/ILL: When an ILL request was placed from the PAC, it displayed in the Staff Client's Request Manager (RM) without the ISO standard Medium Type (Format) value. The format now displays in all views of the RM as well as in the Patron Status. Note: The ILL format still does not display in the ILL workform or in the ILL Find Tool results.		9549
POL-4211	5.5	Circulation/INN-Reach: When the Polaris lending library cancelled an INN-Reach request through the Find Tool, the API message contained a reason string of 'No reason supplied.' This message has been changed to 'INN-Reach request cancelled by the owning library.'
